The health problems facing at-risk low-income men, women, children and families in New York are daunting. They impact every aspect of daily life and they are intensifying.

A Real Opportunity

- help women have healthy babies, teens avoid pregnancy, and people with HIV/AIDS get essential care and support;

- make progress on problems that are especially tough to solve through research and evaluation to develop and test new and creative approaches.

A Sharp Focus

The Solutions Fund invests in six essential areas:

Infant and Child Health and Development: Enhancing child health and development from the earliest ages and linking at-risk children to services;

Access to Healthcare: Helping the uninsured get health insurance and the healthcare they need;

Women's Health: Enabling women to make informed health decisions, prevent unintended pregnancy, and have healthy babies;

HIV/AIDS Prevention and Care: Preventing the spread of HIV infection and developing networks of care for those with HIV and AIDS;

Research for Action: Studying patterns of disease and risk factors, evaluating the effectiveness of current programs, and developing better prevention and health promotion strategies and interventions;

Strengthening Community Care: Building the capacity of community-based health and human service organizations to be more effective and efficient.
