







OUR COMMUNITY WORK

Public Health Solutions (PHS) is the largest public health nonprofit serving New York City that provides communitybased services in many languages for New Yorkers who want to get healthy and stay healthy.

We provide nutrition education, breastfeeding support, and WIC checks to purchase nutritious foods for eligible pregnant and nursing women, infants, and children up to age five. We help your family enroll in WIC and support you and your children to stay healthy through healthy eating and physical activity. We are located in the Bronx, Brooklyn, and Queens.

WIC is a program of the New York State Department of Health funded by the U.S. Department of Agriculture. PHS administers the Neighborhood WIC Program under contract with the New York State Department of Health. We help eligible individuals and families apply to the NYC Human Resources Administration for the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP, also known as Food Stamps). Our counselors help you find out if you qualify, gather required documents, submit your application, and provide referrals to other programs you may need. We are located in the Bronx, Brooklyn, Manhattan, Queens, and Staten Island.



Health Insurance Enrollment Navigator

We help eligible families and individuals enroll in health insurance through the NY State of Health Marketplace. Our trained staff provide one-on-one assistance with applications and renewals and walk you through the sign-up process step-by-step. We are located in the Bronx, Brooklyn, Manhattan, Queens, Staten Island, and Long Island.

Facilitated Enrollment for the Aged, Blind, and Disabled

Our Facilitated Enrollment for the Aged, Blind, and Disabled (FE-ABD) program helps individuals who are age 65 and older, or certified blind, or living with disabilities to apply for Medicaid and the Medicare Savings Program through the New York City Human Resources Administration. We also help individuals renew their existing Medicaid coverage. We are located in the Bronx, Brooklyn, Manhattan, Queens, and Staten Island.













SEXUAL AND REPRODUCTIVE HEALTH

For New York City, where nearly a fifth of the population lives below the poverty line, and more than 700,000 adults lack health insurance, access to SRH services is essential to positive health outcomes. PHS' Sexual and Reproductive Health work crosses three major areas: we operate two health centers in some of the poorest neighborhoods of New York City serving 4,000 women, men, and adolescents each year; we connect with over 5,000 teenagers annually in public schools to provide SRH education and support; and we build the capacity of primary care practices across the city to provide contraceptive information and services.





Family Support Services

We offer a variety of services to support pregnant and parenting families so they have the tools they need to give their babies the best possible start in life. Our Nurse Home Visitors, Family Support Workers, and Community Health Workers offer one-on-one health and parenting education in the home, and group support during pregnancy and through early childhood. These services are voluntary and free. We also provide support to expecting and parenting adolescents and young adults by connecting them to services throughout all five boroughs. We are located in Brooklyn, Queens, and Staten Island.





Smoke-Free Housing

All New Yorkers deserve to breathe clean, smoke-free air where they live, work, and play. Our NYC Smoke-Free team works to protect the health of New Yorkers through tobacco control policy, advocacy, and education. Our work in smoke-free housing aims to increase smoke-free protections in housing to ensure no family or child is forced to endure harmful secondhand smoke pollution in their home. We have staff in the Bronx, Brooklyn, Manhattan, and Queens who can provide guidance and technical assistance on making your condo, co-op, or rental smoke-free.
